AWARD INFORMATION

Are you or do you know someone who has contributed significant time, talent and energy to the Georgia Association of Recovery Residences and/or to the field of recovery in the State of Georgia? Have you organized an outstanding program promoting the tenets of recovery? Celebrate our past & present by applying for or nominating someone for one of the Georgia Association of Recovery Residences awards. Just submit this form (copy as needed for multiple submissions) and no more than **three (3) typed narrative pages** describing the nominee(s) and how they meet the stated criteria of the intended awards(s) as outlined below.

Award Categories:

- **Outstanding Recovery Residence:** The Outstanding Recovery Residence will be judged on overall impact, empowerment of people in recovery, conducting strength-based need assessments, delivering recovery education and training, service to community, use of evidence-based services, modeling hope and overall effectiveness.
- **Outstanding Recovery Event:** The Outstanding Recovery Event will be evaluated based on the program's overall impact on its intended improvements for the field of recovery and/or raising awareness regarding recovery. Be specific regarding type, extent, goals, reach, and service. You may nominate as many events/programs as you wish from the August 2009-August 2010.
- **Outstanding Recovery Advocate:** The Outstanding Recovery Advocate nominations will be evaluated on qualities that relate to their advocacy for recovery – for institutional and social policies that counter stigma and replace discrimination with resources for building recovery capital.
- **Outstanding Peer Leadership Award:** The Outstanding Peer Leadership nominations will be evaluated on qualities that relate to the leadership provided for residents in recovery, the proven ability to plan, design, deliver, and/or evaluate services empowerment of people in recovery and service to the recovery community.
- **Outstanding Contributions to GARR:** These nominations will be evaluated based on contributions to the goals and mission of the Georgia Association of Recovery Residences which may include : improvement of services provided by GARR, improvement of the standards for recovery residences, enhancement of the recovery-based knowledge and skills of GARR Membership, implementation of institutional and social policies that counter stigma and replace discrimination, and service to GARR. The criteria should address credible contributions and not just longevity.
- **While there is no limit to the number of awards you may submit, we encourage members to send only one entry per award category.**
